

Chemical Management and Radiological Controls

NOTE: *Under no circumstances shall a person other than the CAES Safety Officer (SO) bring any chemicals, gasses, radiological sources, or radiological materials into the CAES facility.*

- All chemicals and gasses brought into the CAES facility by the CAES SO shall be entered into the CAES Chemical Inventory database.
- All radiological sources, and radiological materials brought into the CAES facility must be requested from and approved by the CAES SO, purchased by ISU, and then brought into the CAES facility by the CAES SO, and entered into the CAES Radiological Inventory database.
- Training on the CAES chemical management and radiological control processes is provided as part of General Laboratory training for all users of CAES laboratories. Should an office resident need to bring chemicals or radiological materials or sources into or use such in the CAES facility, they must first complete the **CAES Chemical Management and Radiological Controls** training module. Each module explains the process, roles, and responsibilities associated with chemical management and radiological controls from the request and approval process through the disposal process.
