Management commitment, line ownership, and workforce involvement are the fundamental drivers of safety coupled with excellent safety systems and practices. The fundamental purpose of the CAES Safety Advisory Board is to provide an active and meaningful venue for CAES partnering institutions to maintain ownership and buy-in to CAES Environment Safety & Health (ES&H) processes and products.

The Board serves as a forum for ES&H professionals and CAES leadership to exchange safety information and pursue convergence to a common safety culture across the CAES partnering organizations. Board member responsibilities are to:

- Participate in quarterly Board meetings
- Conduct independent surveillances of CAES processes
- Serve as an advocate for and endorse CAES processes
- Identify opportunities for leveraging ES&H processes and products between CAES institutions and between CAES and CAES partnering institutions
- Pulse CAES users for feedback and input on implementation and effectiveness of CAES ES&H processes
